If the 2020 Census certifies that Bozeman has a population of 50,000 or more people, then Streamline's primary funding source will change! While this doesn't necessarily mean Streamline will get more federal funding, it does set up a framework for stronger interaction between Streamline, the City, and the County through the mandatory creation of a Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO).
