City of Bozeman Budget

The City of Bozeman has allocated \$150,000 for Streamline in the upcoming fiscal year. However, Streamline requested \$300,000 in funding. We are disappointed about this lower allocation and are worried about what it will mean for Streamline service this fall and winter. As we've mentioned before, our goal is to ultimately form an Urban Transit District in the upcoming years (similar to the Parks District recently passed by Bozeman). However, in order to form the district, we need to show voters that we are an important and essential service that benefits ALL residents. Thus, we need **MULTIPLE** people to give public comment during the June 15th Bozeman Commission meeting. Please email vpalmer@thehrdc.org if you are interested.
